Enrolment:

Parking:

We have been made aware on a number of occasions of some issues with regard to parking/ dropping off children in the morning. The vast majority of people adhere to the drop and go and/or parking the car in the car park. From the mornings that I have been out there I would suggest that things could be improved further by (i) ensuring that the person who is dropping off children knows the system (ii) use the drop off area as that a drop off area. The driver should not be leaving the car to walk the children in and (iii) if the drop off area is full, just use the car park at the back of the school. Don't wait for a space in the drop off area to appear. The most important aspect in all of this is the safety of the children walking in and out of the school and we would just remind parents/guardians to exercise extreme caution when in and around the environs of the school.

School Self Evaluation:

This year as part of SSE we are looking at the area of Gaeilge and in particular Caint Neamhfhoirmiúil (Informal Irish). We are encouraging children to use their cúpla focail throughout the day. Each week we are having a "Frása na Seachtaine" for both the Junior and Senior end of the school. We are also having a "Gaeilgeoir na Seachtaine".
